2021-2022 Dress Code

Per district guidance, face masks/coverings are required to be worn indoors at all HISD schools, facilities, and buildings, regardless of vaccination status, and must cover the nose and the mouth (unless medically unable per medical documentation submitted to campus). Face masks/coverings must be school-appropriate (no references to alcohol, sex, drugs, weapons, etc.)

Shirts

A school appropriate shirt or a Furr High School spirit/club shirt (All shirts must have sleeves, may not be rolled up/tied, cut up, etc., and must cover entire mid-riff area) No references to alcohol, sex, drugs, weapons, etc.

Pants

Any style pants, shorts, capris, or skirts Holes in jeans may not expose skin and may not be excessive in size Shorts and skirts must approach the knee Must sit at the waist, no "sagging" No excessively tight/revealing pants/shorts (such as leggings, compression shorts, etc.)

> **Hoodies/Sweaters/Jackets** Hoods on any clothing may not be on No references to alcohol, sex, drugs, weapons, etc.

Shoes and Socks House slippers/shower shoes are NOT allowed Socks of any color may be worn No references to alcohol, sex, drugs, weapons, etc

Accessories

You may NOT carry around duffel bags, sports bags, etc. No headgear may be worn inside (hats, bandanas, or cloth hair accessories) unless for religious purposes

Grooming

Students are expected to show good judgment and show respect for themselves and others in their grooming (no distracting hair styles and/or hair colors)

No notched eyebrows

Other dress code standards may be adopted by the campus if necessary and/or for the safety of all students and staff at Furr High School @FurrHS
