SKIRTS/SHORTS	<ol> <li>Knee-length shorts/skirts with no slits, <u>must not</u> <u>be shorter than one inch above the knee while</u> <u>standing.</u> (Leggings may be worn under skirts and must be <u>black or navy</u>.)</li> </ol>	1. Navy blue / Black / Khaki / White
HOODIES/ SWEATSHIRTS/ SWEATERS/ JACKETS	<ol> <li>HSLJ Logo/Approved club, College, Military Branch or solid color with no visible logo.</li> <li>(Hoods <b>MUST</b> remain OFF at ALL times.)</li> </ol>	1. Navy Blue / White / Grey / Black
SHOES	<ol> <li>Closed toe and closed heel.</li> <li>NO sandals, crocs or croc style, flip flops, slides or house shoes.</li> </ol>	1. Any color
OTHER	<ul> <li>Students must have their ID Badges on them daily.</li> <li>HEADGEAR: Hair wrapped with scarf allowed – NO caps, hats, bonnets, sunglasses, bandanas, du-rags, etc. Proper hygiene and grooming applicable to all students.</li> </ul>	

## **\*\*ADDITIONAL DRESS CODE GUIDELINES\*\***

## Students are PROHIBITED from wearing the following:

- Shirts/sweatshirts that have a logo bigger 2in x 4in in size on front & back
- Plain non-school colors (need to be HSLJ, College/University/Military)
- Pants with rips, holes or embellishments
- Sweatpants, leggings, or yoga pants (non-pants, khakis or jeans material)
- Flannels, stripping, patterns or anything with more than two colors

## **Dress Code Violations:**

Responses to dress code violations are restorative.

- Students are given an opportunity to self-correct or get parental support when they are not following the dress code.
- Students who are unable to arrive to school in proper dress code, will be placed in I.S.S to keep students in school and doing work, but isolate them from the rest of the student body.
