1. Introductions/Good Things

Attendees greeted each other and our purpose statement was read.

2. MOY Updates

GT testing: After reviewing scores, teacher recommendations, parent requests, a total of 109 students were tested.

Attendance: student increased 2% from last year, staff improved by 5%

Discipline: 1 student received OSS (out of school suspension) versus 4 last year this was contributed by several things such as Capturing Kids Heart, schoolwide systems, student engagement and visibility of administration.

Data Glows: Math low category decreased in 5 out of 6 grade levels tested and the number of student scoring in high category increased 3 out of 6 grade levels tested. Science low category decreased in 2 out of 4 grade levels, low average category decreased in 2 out of 4 grade levels, and average/high average increased 3 out of 4 grade levels. Reading 3 out of 4 grade levels increased and a notable surge in high average especially 2nd graders along with a decrease in low average for 4th graders. DIBELS 4 out of 5 grade levels tested decreased in the Below Benchmark, 3 out of 5 grade levels tested increased in At Benchmark category and 2 out of 5 grade levels increased in Above Benchmark category.

Data Grows: Math master schedule reconfigured to insure interventions are given to help primary students grow. Science movement has been in small increments, challenge will be to make sure science is intervened in non-testing grades as well as in 5th grade. Reading intervention for 2nd graders facilitated by 2nd grade teachers and LSAE Fridays to provide targeted support. Reading, maintain At/Above Benchmark Tier 1 students and provide support for Below/Well Below Benchmark Tier 2/3 students.

Tier I Instruction: Data analysis, PLC to assist with internalization and customization of lessons, unpacking standards with instructional coaching and feedback.

2nd Teach/3rd Teach: Intentional planning, identify the misconception, early childhood interventions, LSAE Friday with data driven instructional decisions, Saturday school, online challenges ST Math/Boost.

3. Staffing Updates

Staff leveling occurred in Oct 2023 at which time we combined first grade into two classes and three teachers retired. Since that time staffing has been consistent.
