- 4. School Safety and Health Overview
  - a. HISD mask mandate remains in place despite recent legislative challenges. Unknown whether mask mandate will continue in spring semester
  - b. Safety Drills 3 completed with mental preparation of students by Ms. Elam
  - c. TOL ongoing as needed and utilized more extensively in late October when a classroom required
    - i. 3 students currently in online learning
    - ii. unsure if these online learning options will continue to spring semester
- 5. School Achievement
  - a. Testing next week will drive need for tutoring and interventions
  - b. Hispanic Heritage Parade featured on HISD video
  - c. GT notifications will be sent out by district 1/7/22; testing continues until 12/18
- 6. Budget and enrollment
  - a. Recapture at end of October and was 370 students; current is 367
  - b. River Oaks is now serving as HUB school since Sinclair is capped
  - c. Lottery for pre-K/Kinder starting soon
  - d. Mustang Roundup event tentatively set for 2/16/22
  - e. Staffing

- i. Another 2<sup>nd</sup> grade teacher will join in January to split Morretti's class 15 and 15. Morretti will teach Math/Reading and other hire remaining subjects.
- ii. May add a 3<sup>rd</sup> Pre-K teacher depending on registration/demand
- iii. Coach Prieto will leave in December; replacement will be hired. Certified Librarian to join staff in 2021-2022 school year, recruiting in April 2021
- iv. One other staff member is leaving Memorial, and their role will be filled
- v. Marshall request to add 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teacher to avoid 30 student classroom
- vi. Palacios how is it decided which grades get priority for new teacher?

  - b. Catapult Organization offering tutorials in accordance with HB 4545
  - c. Camp Spark 12/21-12/22 will provide intervention to students who register. Seven teachers will provide service at \$50/hour
