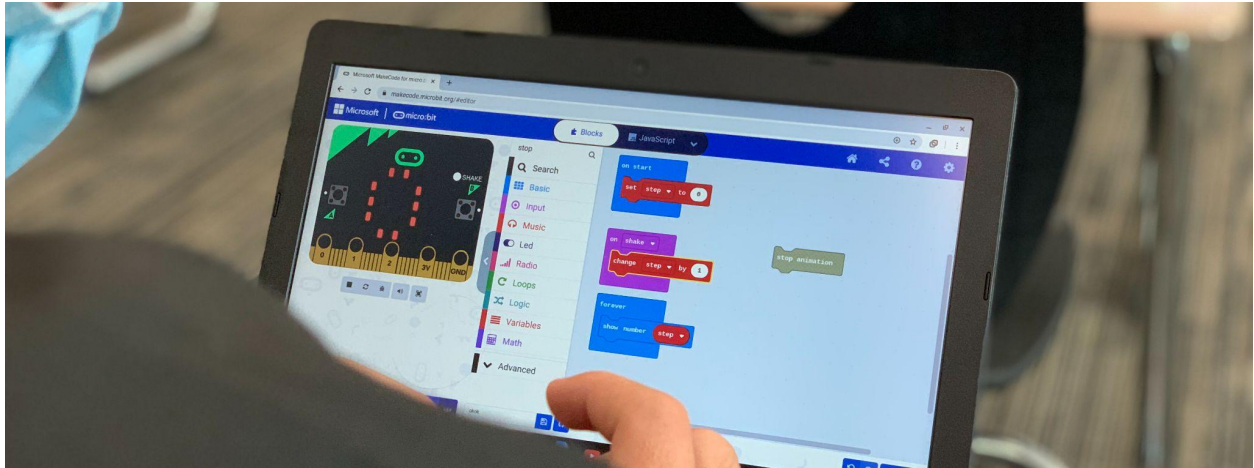


Teaching Machines to Learn
