7. Master Schedule Update

F. Hernandez: We will go ahead and begin with the Master Schedule and where we are at this point in preparation for next school year.

- Master Schedule basic structure has been created for 2023-2024

 F. Hernandez: With support form district personnel, our basic Master Schedule for next year has been created in Power School. At our request, they added a 3rd day, C- Day, which is the day where all periods will meet except for AVID.
