SDMC Virtual Meeting held via TEAMS.


The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m. Attendance is reflected on the sign-in sheet.

Dr. Garcia welcomed the committee to the third quarterly meeting. She shared with committee the CIP and Action Plan to be distributed to the staff. Committee members reviewed and agreed with these documents.


Dr. Garcia reviewed MOY NWEA math and reading data with committee. She explained that due to low achievement our scholars' growth must be above the 60th percentile so that achievement can improve. Zearn is currently being used as math intervention. Students in grades 1st and 2nd grade must complete at least three on-grade level lessons per week, while students in grades 3rd-5th must complete at least five on-grade level lessons per week. To address reading, our students will start using the Amira program in grades kinder through 5th grade for at lease 20 minutes a day during intervention time.

Ms. Carwell expressed the importance of teachers speaking to their students about doing their best while they are taking the assessment and the correlation between working hard every day so that they can show all they have learned on the next NWEA assessment. The MOY window will be May 14 to the 17.
