Welcome to Sterling Aviation High School. Parking is a privilege and in order to maintain a safe and secure parking environment, there are several regulations and expectations that should be maintained and adhered to throughout the school year.

Both parent and student are to initial and sign below, verifying that the expectations and procedures for parking at Sterling Aviation High School are understood. Please let us know if you have any questions.

Please initial on each of the highlighted topics.

_____/_____/_____My initials verify that I understand motor vehicles driven on school grounds must be operated in conformance with regulations of the State of Texas, Harris County, Houston, Houston ISD, and Texas Board of Education. Failure to comply with school regulations or with the directions of any SAHS staff member will result in suspension or revocation of the student's parking permit

_____/_____/_____My initials verify that I understand that motor vehicles parked on school grounds must be visibly display the annual permit. Vehicles without a visibly displayed permit will be warned, stickered, wheel locked or towed at the owner's expense.

_____/_____/_____My initials verify that vehicles should be locked at all times. The school is not responsible for vehicles or their contents while they are parked on school property.

_____/_____/_____My initials verify that I understand that the privilege of bringing a student-operated motor vehicle onto school premises is hereby conditioned by the owner of the motor vehicle and the parent or guardian of the student to allow a search of that motor vehicle when there is a reasonable suspicion for the search of that motor vehicle, Student vehicles are subject to search if there is a reason to believe drugs, alcohol, stolen property, or other illegal items might be present in that vehicle. Anything found in a student's vehicle is considered to be his/her possession. Refusal to provide access to a motor vehicle shall be cause for termination, without further hearing, of the privilege of bringing a motor vehicle onto school premises,

_____/_____/_____My, initials verify that any vehicle parked illegally in fire lanes, handicapped or in another person's reserved space designated by its permit, will be warned, wheel locked* and/or towed. Tickets may be issued for parking in a fire lane and/or handicap parking spaces.

_____/_____/_____My initials verify that I understand that students are NOT allowed to loiter in their vehicles or in the school's parking lots, before, during, or after school.

_____/_____/_____My initials verify that I understand that revocation of permits may occur for the following reasons: not parking in assigned space; careless driving, speeding and/or repeated parking/ driving violations; repeated discipline issues or violations of the Student Code of Conduct: attendance issues such as excessive absences, tardiness, neglect of detention obligations or other repeating offenses as determined by the administration; failure to return school-issued items such as textbooks, library materials, or any other school property; selling or altering the permit in any way.

_____/_____/_____My initials verify that I understand that regular parking permits are \$50.00. ONLY CASH IS ACCEPTED. Lost permits may be replaced at a cost of \$50.00. Parking permits sold to a student are for use by that student only. All students involved in the purchase and subsequent resale of a permit or using a permit that does not belong to them will be disciplined. Forgery of permits may result in a police citation, loss of parking privileges, and/or school suspension.
