WHAT KIND OF INFORMATION ARE WE SHARING?

- General admissions information
- Specific art programs, schools and/or conservatories may have their own admissions criteria and enrollment process
 - Pre-screeners
 - Auditions
 - Portfolios
 - Interviews

OPTIONS AFTER GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL

College Freshman/First Year Admissions

- Attend a 4 year university in August after graduating high school
- Uses high school GPA and possibly SAT/ACT scores for admissions

College Transfer Admissions

- First, attend a 2 college (ig. Houston Community College) after graduating high school and then transfer to a 4 year university as a college student
- Each college has their own transfer requirements
- University of Houston's current Assured Admission Transfer Requirements: 15 or more hours (5 classes) with a 2.5 GPA or higher
- Not always a guarantee

Earn certifications through specialized programs

• Many available at community colleges, potentially earning an Associate's Degree (ex. Welding)

Enter the workforce

Can also be used as a gap year before entering a college or university

Join the military

• Attend college or university later using the GI Bill and have it be 100% paid for

TEXAS AUTOMATIC ADMISSIONS LAW

Top 10% of students in a class who graduate from a Texas public high school are automatically admitted into any Texas public university after they apply

 *Exception - University of Texas at Austin only automatically accepts the top 6% of a graduating class

Assured Admissions

- Some Texas Public Universities offer "Assured Admissions" based on class ranking or GPA and ACT/or SAT scores
- See chart on next slide

Holistic Review

- Allows colleges to consider each student as a unique, whole person rather than a numerical test score result and considers:
 - Essays
 - Letters of recommendation
 - Resume
 - Leadership and other experiences
 - Interview, audition, other

Offered to any graduate of a Texas public school is not offered first year admissions to TAMU.

GOOD NEWS!

There were 181 students who graduated in 2021, the top 6% = 10 students.

- Of the students who applied to UT Austin in class of 2021, 28 students were accepted as first year applicants.
- Class of 2021 was offered over \$20,426,105 in scholarship money <u>during a pandemic.</u>
- The class of 2020 was offered over \$25 million in scholarship money.

HSPVA students stand out!

- You stand out because you have shown commitment and leadership on a deeper level than comprehensive high school students due to the rigor of our art area programs.
- You stand out because you have shown a deep spike of interest in something which you devote 3 or more hours every day to and balance your academics on top of it.
- You stand out because of the wisdom and life lessons you have learned and the self-awareness and growth you display in the classroom, in your programs, and in your extra-curricular art commitments.

JUNIORS NEED TO KNOW

HSPVA PSAT is Wednesday, October 13th

 Results will be helpful in determining how you may do on the SAT and how you can best prepare.

HSPVA Junior SAT is Wednesday, March 2 – no need to sign up for this date and fees are waived

- You should already have a College Board account from the PSAT, don't create a new one!
- Complete the socio-economic form for PVA because you may qualify for an SAT or ACT fee waiver.
- If you want to take more tests outside of PVA, it is recommended to test in spring. See dates and register at:
 - ACT: Act.org
 - SAT: Collegeboard.org

JUNIOR FAQ'S ABOUT SAT AND ACT

Question: Do you need the SAT and/or ACT for college admissions?

Answer: Each university determines their own admissions requirements.

- Students must check the website for requirements and updates
- Some schools may be "test optional" which means and SAT/or ACT score is not required for admissions, but if it helps you then submit
- Schools may be test optional for admissions but may use the SAT/ or ACT for scholarships,
- Some schools who chose to be test optional for admissions during the pandemic may only be test optional for another year and it may not apply to your senior class

Question: How do I prepare for the PSAT, ACT, or SAT?

Answer: There are a lot of resources to assist with test prep.

- Printable SAT practice tests are available free online
- There are a lot of books and study guides that can be purchases to help
- Private tutors or tutoring services such as Revolution Prep

- Many test prep apps for the phone!
- Some apps will send you an SAT/ACT question a day








