
ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES



VIRTUAL INSTRUCTION

- Teachers will deliver instruction via the **HUB**, while using **Microsoft Teams** to facilitate short direct and small group instruction.
- Student's learning experience is self-guided with teacher interaction/support in which students engage in learning instructional material on their own time. Students complete self-paced and personalized activities via the HUB and other district-provided digital resources (Imagine Learning, MyOn, Smarty Ants)
- The school will provide supplies needed for virtual instruction.
- No uniforms required. However, each students' appearance should reflect a positive image of the school during instructional time.

- **Students assignment submission via the HUB** for each scheduled class. When unable to submit via the HUB students can submit assignments via emails, photos, phone conferences or other forms of documentation.


GRADING POLICY

ENROLLMENT

- HISD is moving from a paper-based to electronic-based enrollment process. You are still able to collect paper-based enrollment at the campus for the 2020-2021 school year. Monday-Friday 9:00AM 1:00PM.
- Beginning August 17th, 2020 Parents can begin completing the online enrollment for new students. Using this new system, parents will also have the capability to upload required documentation (birth certificate, copy of utility bill, etc.)
