STAYING SAFE AT LOVETT

As we continue to work F2F, there are some key points for everyone to remember:

1. If your child is sick, please keep them at home. **DO NOT COME TO SCHOOL IF YOU ARE FEELING ILL**, this means any fever, cough, chills, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, loss of taste/smell or any other flu or Covid symptoms
2. If anyone in your close family or contact has been exposed to or has tested positive for Covid, notify the school nurse and do not send your child to school – even if they don't have symptoms
3. Continue to practice good hand-washing and mask etiquette. Masks should cover the nose and mouth, and fit snugly, without gaps
