BE MED READY FOR NEXT YEAR

All medications given at school require physician orders. This includes over the counter medications.

Be ready for the first day of school by having your physician complete medications and other health needs forms prior to the start of the 2021-2022 school year.

MEDICATIONS AND SUMMER SCHOOL

HISD policy is that all at school medications go home at the end of the school year. If your child is taking summer school this year, their medications will stay at school until July 8.

ALL OTHER MEDICATIONS WILL GO HOME ON FRIDAY, JUNE 11.

MEDICATIONS LEFT AT SCHOOL, WILL BE DISPOSED OF, AS PER HISD POLICY.

All at school orders for medications must be renewed at the beginning of the school year. If you had medications at school this year, the nurse will follow up with you in July to have new orders in place for the 2021-2022 year.

IMMUNIZATON RECORDS

If you are leaving the school at the end of this year or need an immunization record for camp or other reason, contact the school nurse to receive an updated copy for your files. Once your child leaves the school, the nurse can no longer access those records.

SEE TO SUCCEED PROGRAM TO CONTINUE DURING THE SUMMER

If your child needs new glasses, contact the school nurse to sign up for HISD See to Succeed program. Free visual exam and glasses are available through this HISD program all summer.

Parents are responsible for transport to appointments

KEEP YOUR IMMUNIZATION RECORDS UP TO DATE

If your child has received any immunization boosters or other shots this year, be sure to send a copy of those immunizations to the Lovett school nurse, so your HISD Immunization Records remain current.
