II. Standing Business

a. Staffing 2023-2024

- i. Current Positions
 - 1. Parent Engagement Rep- Open
 - -Tinoco left the city/HISD, also supported Roman in LPAC/504 clerical position. Do we do Parent Engagement Rep or Clerk position. The goal for Parent Engagement Rep was/is to get more Hispanic families involved. Support is needed for Roman. Parent Engagement, where are we lacking and need support? Title I funds support Parent Engagement.
 - 2. Dance Teacher/Long Term Sub
 - -several plans have fallen through. Agreed last time to hire full time dance. No applicants worked out for the full-time position. Currently a long-term sub is in the classroom but has no dance experience. Interested applicants for the dance position but for next year. Possibly holding off for the remainder of this year until next year. Possibly open an hourly position. Competition in February for Razorettes.

b. Facilities

- i. Atriums
 - -PTA redid the atriums, filled in the turtle pond, drainage issues fixed and other enhancements.
- ii. HVAC
 - -7 classrooms cold last week, fixed then it was too hot.
- iii. Gym; Paint
 - -rails in gym and locker rooms painted. Lockers are in transit from Canada. Painted but no lockers. Weightroom has been painted and new floors. At cost to PTA.
- c. Safety
 - i. Safety Meeting for Students/Parents/Faculty & Staff
 - -met before/after break for protocol. Saldana held grade level expectations in assemblies. Parent meeting held \sim 25 parents attended.
 - ii. Door Audits
 - -Officer Stokes does weekly audits on all doors.
 - iii. Discipline
 - -Steward compared last year to this year. ISS and OSS decreased overall. DAEP increased for Vapes and Threats. We are on track to be under last year # from 22-23 for ISS and OSS.

- a. Grad Lab Promotions
 - -4 6th graders were promoted to 7th grade
 - -3 7^{th} graders were promoted to 8^{th} grade
 - -3 8th graders are still in the program earning HS credit via APEX learning
- b. Testing- NWEA MAP
 - -normed test, nationally tested/percentile rankings
 - -72% growth in math, 68% growth in reading, 54% growth in science
 - -parent communication will go out, data tied to STAAR projections
 - -individual conversations with students with deficits
 - -MAP replaced Renaissance
 - -tied to Admin appraisal, tied to student growth
