SDMC Minutes

January 17, 2020

Members Present: Ms. Bazan, Ms. Espinoza, Ms. Hernandez (5th), Ms. Bruckner (4th), Mr. Medina (3rd), Ms. Garcia (2nd), Ms. Arzola (1st), Ms. Castillo (PK-K), and Mr. Lam (FA).

- **BUDGET:** Ms. Bazan discussed attending the Budget Conference and learning we were 11 students short of meeting projected enrollment leaving us at 524/535 students currently enrolled. Janowski owed the district back approximately \$24,000. Monies leftover will go to test prep, substitutes, tutorials, etc. If teachers need materials they may put in a request and if possible, may be open to receive said request. The staff will discuss projections for 2020/2021 school year next meeting.
- **SPRING FIELD TRIPS:** Ms. Bazan has suggested teachers should start looking for field trip ideas for the spring semester as dates will be needed soon to ensure all logistical needs (food, transport, costs) are met in advance. Lower grade level field trips are to be held prior to the May12-14 STAAR test dates.
- **SATURDAY CAMP:** 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grade teachers were asked about when they would like to begin Saturday Camp. Likely start dates will be January 25th or the first week of February from 8:30-11:30am. Representatives were asked to get with their teams and settle on a date by Tuesday January 21st. 3rd Grade will be focusing on Reading and Math. 4th Grade will be focusing on Writing. 5th Grade will decide amongst which content areas to target. Teachers were asked to target *growth point* students and regressing students.
- **SAFETY and SECURITY:** Ms. Bazan brought up the recent shooting at an HISD high school and the concerns it raises about the practices of *that* respective school as well as our own. The administration and staff will revisit Janowski's safety plans. Key concerns are students in 4th and 5th grade who may be prone to project potentially hostile behavior or mental health setbacks. The idea of having Ms. Mendez and Ms. Tritico provide organized opportunities for the student body to discuss important safe practices such as "see something, say something" was brought up and will most likely be implemented. Teachers should become mindful when students share potentially harmful information and not be dismissive. As well, students (and teachers) are not to open doors for strangers unless it is for a known campus teacher or personnel. Stay vigilant.
- **QUESTIONS or CONCERNS:** *Spring Bookfair* will be held February 7-14th in the library. PK-2nd Grade *Field Day* will be held on April 24th. 3rd-5th Grade *Field Day* will be held on May 20th. Field Day logistics were presented concerning an hour-long lunch period to tackle necessities, prizes, and game ideas. Teachers were asked to split incoming new students evenly amongst Ancillary groups. Coach Moore has requested assistance with Fine Arts groups. Mr. Medina discussed tardy concerns amongst Third Grade students. Ms. Bazan informed us of the Parent Contracts for tardiness and meeting with parents of often tardy students.
