## **T. H. Rogers After-School Enrichment Program Policies and Procedures**

**REGISTRATION FEE \$25.00.** Registration is complete only upon receipt of a signed registration form and at least 1/2 of the payment due. You may submit your payment either by Check or Money Order. We cannot accept cash.

**EXTENDED PAYMENT PLAN** is available to you as a convenience. We are solely dependent on payment of tuition and fees to meet our expenses. First payment (1/2 of Grand Total) is due upon registration; Second payment (1/2 of Grand Total) is due Monday, March 6, 2017. Please make your payments in a timely manner to avoid the \$25.00 late fee charges.

**CLASS CANCELLATION.** If your child is enrolled in an Enrichment class and it is canceled due to lack of enrollment, a full refund for that class will be issued.

**NO AFTER CLASS SUPERVISION.** Absolutely no supervision is provided after enrichment classes are dismissed. All children must be picked up in the cafeteria and signed out promptly when class is dismissed or you will be charged a late pick-up fee of \$2.00 per minute starting at 4:30 p.m. After the 5<sup>th</sup> late pick-up, your child may be suspended from the program. Parents must sign out their child/children in the cafeteria. T. H. **CONDUCT/DISCIPLINE.** In order to provide a safe and nurturing environment in which to teach Enrichment classes, students must exhibit appropriate behavior. Children enrolled in Enrichment classes are expected to follow the HISD Code of Conduct required at T. H. Rogers. Children who fail to conduct themselves according to this standard will be given a warning and their parents will be notified of their misconduct. Continued misconduct will result in notification to T. H. Rogers's administrators and/or suspension from the Enrichment Program. Children suspended from the Enrichment program for misconduct will not be entitled to a refund of any tuition, fees, or registration paid.

**NOTIFICATION.** It is important that you notify the Enrichment office in writing or via e-mail when your child will be absent. Please make sure the Enrichment office has all updated information on your child: such as an address change and medical information. #### **Basketball/Cross-Fit (K-8)**

**Instructed by: Coach Lyons**

Basketball Cross-Fit is a combination of basketball fundamentals and personal fitness. We will work on ball handling, shooting, passing and overall core basketball, while working on physical fitness and conditioning. The children will go through drills, do push-ups, sit-ups, jumping jacks as well as core exercises. Water breaks will be as needed, the children can break whenever they feel the need to get water but we will stop every seven to ten minutes for breaks as a group.

#### **Computer Class (3-8)**

**Instructed by: Monart Drawing Studio**

**Prerequisite:** Experience with digital illustration and computer animation.

This course will teach 3D digital rendition (similar to sculpting clay on a computer) and introductory game design including two-dimensional characters and playing fields.

#### **Gymnastics (K-4)**

**Instructed by: Coach Heather**

For beginners and intermediate gymnast. You will learn new skills in floor tumbling, balance beam, and mini-trampolines. Do you want to learn how to do a cartwheel, aerial, or maybe a back handspring? Come join our fun and exciting class and you will soon learn new tricks to wow all your friends and family.

#### **Gymnastics (5-8)**

**Instructed by: Coach Heather**

Here's your opportunity to get a fun and exciting workout while learning something new. Whether you have had gymnastics experience before or not, you will learn and develop new talents in this class. We will teach you intermediate skills in tumbling, balance beam, and mini-trampolines. Health and fitness information and advice is part of each class. All skill levels are welcome.

**Karate/Martial Arts (K-8)****Instructed by: Soo Bak Do Houston Martial Arts School**

This is a self-defense class where students will be taught discipline, respect, and self-defense techniques. This class is designed for fun while obtaining a positive learning experience. They will focus on physical and mental development. Some of the topics for this class are: respect, discipline, basic-blocking techniques, and physical fitness; plus games that will teach coordination, balance, flexibility and nutrition.

**Mad Science (K-6)****Instructed by: Mad Science of Houston****Maximum: 20 students**

Through its innovative concept of 'Edu-tainment', Mad Science has been able to spark the imagination and curiosity of children everywhere. Their goal is to provide fun, entertaining and exciting activities that instill a clearer understanding of what science is really all about and how it affects the world around them.

**Writing (2-8)****Instructed by: Monart Drawing Studio**

Storybook illustration: This is a creative writing course in which students both write and illustrate their own story. Apart from teaching students how to draw, this class encourages students to use their imagination to create unique stories and tell them in various formats including comic strips, single-panel vignettes, and poems. This class allows students to advance both writing and drawing skills, and is one of our most popular after-school programs.

**Robotics (K-8)****Instructed by: American Robotics Academy****Maximum: 15 students**

Students will learn how to design, build and test remote controlled miniature robots made from Lego Building blocks, including the specialized pieces: axles, gears, beams, wheels, motors, microcomputers, pneumatics and other parts that will enable the student to safely create animated and exciting mechanical movements and other effects. They will understand how things work through hands-on activities that demonstrate the principles of simple and motorized machines, while learning skills of team-work, problem-solving and creative thinking.

All classes will be conducted on our school campus by our own teachers or outside vendors. Registration is on a first come-first serve basis. Please drop your registration form in the front office.
