- 1. Progress on school goals as measured by the School Improvement Plan and Targeted Improvement Plan
 - a. Goals were set in two areas at the start of the year: attendance, referrals.
 - b. Another section examined was in reference to exam scores.
 - i. Where are we in terms of raw numbers? Spring scores don't include December scores and last summer's scores. If a student retests, only the highest score counts in the accountability cycle.
 - c. A Student Data sheet was shared with the committee.
 - i. New students taking the test for the first time (First year newcomers) are factored out of the final results.
 - ii. Concern: comparing our EBs to other campuses may not be the best measure as most of our students did not attend middle school in the district or perhaps this country.
 - 1. Observation: when compared to other EBs, our campus has traditionally outscored other campuses.
 - iii. Raw score averages for Liberty, the district, and the state were shared.
 - iv. There are still some outstanding variables; final accountability results will be shared in August.

2. Professional Development

- a. Math department is attending Carnegie Training this summer to implement a new math curriculum for Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra 2.
- b. June 13th new Canvas user training; June 20th- advanced Canvas user training
- c. June 13th principal/administration training
- d. Summer lesson planning: creating units and plans, and training to support those areas.
 - i. Does that happen after the summer session? Or does that happen on Fridays?
 - ii. What is the actual focus for those planning sessions? The focus and goals will be determined prior to starting work on plans and units.
 - iii. The goal would be for end products to be completed by specific dates.
- e. Training on the new grading system will also be available.
