Note: These instructions are NOT to be used if you decide to use Savvas textbooks in Canvas. Products only need to be assigned at the beginning of the school year or semester. Teachers can NOT manage curriculum products for classes on the Past Classes tab.

If new products (new classes added or not all products were assigned to all classes) need to be assigned, log into the textbook via Clever, open a new tab and type <https://savvaseasybridge.com/> to assign new products.

Step 1. Login to SavvasEasyBridge using the [Canvas Digital Resources](#) page and locate the textbook to assign products.

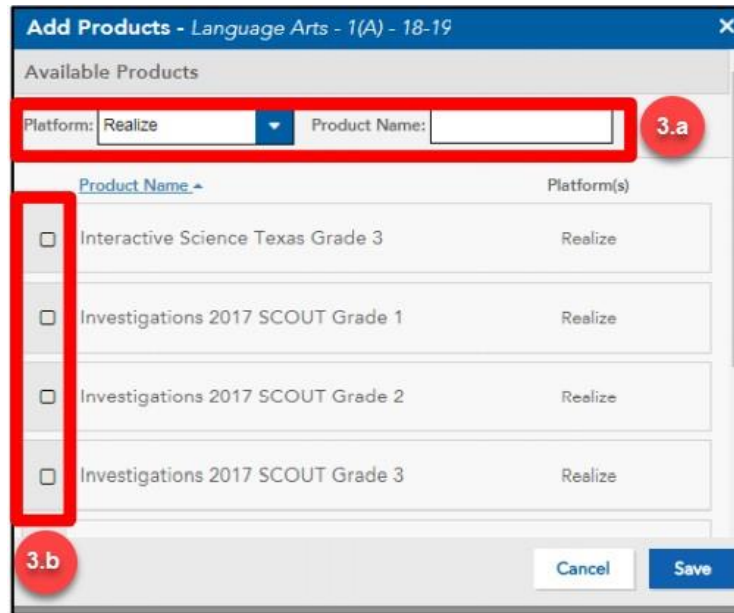
Step 2. Click Add Products to the right of the class name. The products licensed to your school and district appear in the list. You will see the product name and the name of the learning platform.
