- a. Grab Lab

Houston ISD's Graduation Lab Initiative was designed to meet the needs of overage and/or under-credited students as they strive to complete their high school education. The purpose of the initiative is to create campus-based computer labs and programs for high school students that operate with flexible hours to provide access to online courses and tutorials for state and national achievement tests.

At Wheatley HS our online course offering includes a wide variety of credit recovery and original credit options. The term "credit recovery" refers to passage and receipt of credit for a course that was attempted unsuccessfully at a previous time. An online credit recovery student has already accrued sufficient "seat-time" for a course failed in a teacher's classroom, and will recover credit for the failure by demonstrating mastery of the course's TEKS objectives through online assessment and traditional, proctored testing. "Original credit" refers to "first-time" credit, in which a student receives complete instruction that is not limited to the demonstration of competency, as in credit recovery.

b. On Time Grad Academy

On-Time Grad Academy is a non-traditional program that prepares every scholar for on-time graduation by engaging them in an accelerated curriculum and personalized learning path to success.

On-Time Grad Academy offers students multiple avenues to acquire and/or restore high school credit(s) needed for graduation.

Student Eligibility

- 2 or more years overage
- Meeting Academic Standards in current classes

Student Responsibilities

- Log in to course daily
- Complete 100% of course requirements
- Complete one course at time

- Complete course within 10 weeks or less
- Adhere to Academic Honesty Program guidelines
- Seek academic support when needed
