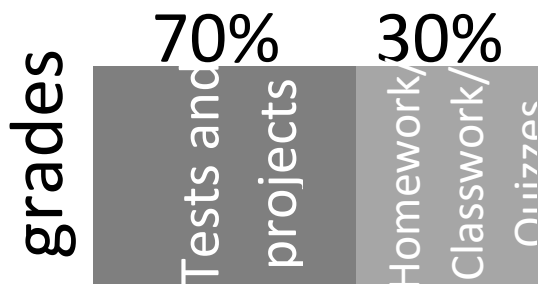

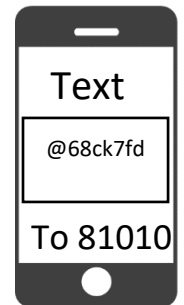

### OVERVIEW

- Students will be expected to read and interpret maps, charts, cartoons, graphs, and primary resources such as personal diaries, political speeches, literary selections, contracts, and newspaper or other media reports.

# grading
