## Students

- Will keep the school/teacher informed when there is a concern that may impact the child's academic performance.

# **Davila's Goals and Focus Areas**

Davila's goal for the 2023 – 2024 school year is to earn the six maximum allowable distinctions on the TEA Accountability Report. We will focus on four goals for this school year:

- <u>Reading and Language Arts Goal:</u> By the end of the 2023 - 2024 school year, the percentage of students who scored at Approaches on STAAR Reading will increase from 88% to 89%, the percentage of students who scored at Meets will increase from 55% to 59%, and Masters will maintain at 24%.
- <u>Math Goal</u>: By the end of the 2023 2024 school year, the percentage of students who scored at approaches on STAAR Math will increase from 88% to 89%, and the percentage of students who scored at Meets will increase from 41% to 59%, and Masters will increase from 25% to 29%.

 Science Goal: By the end of the 2023 – 2024 school year, the percent of students who scored at Approaches on STAAR Science will increase from 75% to 90%, the percent of students who scored at Meets will increase from 18% to 43%, and Masters will increase from 14% to 26%.
