- Sign in sheet reflects that seven of the fifteen members were not present.
- Discussion of celebration (Party on the Patio) for students with exceptional attendance, good behavior, passing all classes, etc. during early dismissal days. The Party on the Patio schedule will be determined later. Reviewed options for the schedule and activities for those students that won't be attending the Party on the Patio. An option of an advocacy period to discuss attendance and grades with the other students was presented.
- Socio-economic forms are at 99% complete and students that qualified for free and reduced lunch reduced by 5%.
- PGPs need to be collected and will be the next focus for compliance.
- First credit recovery was completed and the next one will be November 9.
- Breast Cancer Awareness Day (month of October) to wear pink and have a cake for the survivors at the school on Friday, October 25.
- First time that SAT was offered during school this past Wednesday. PSAT is on Wednesday, October 30. One grade level (10th) will eat lunch in the room. 9th - 11th are taking the PSAT, 12th grade is taking the ASVAB.
- There is still a math teacher, ELA co-teacher, and a CTE teacher opening (Health Science). We are consistently very short on substitute teachers.
- November professional development is a district Safety Training. This is a Mandatory Training, so staff will not be off campus on this date.
- Haunted House and Silent Headphone Party are on Saturday, October 26th. Only Westbury students are allowed at the Haunted House. Students must leave campus after they complete the Haunted House if they are not attending the dance.
