Your contestants are cordially invited to the first annual Carnegie Vanguard High School Math and Science Competition for 6-12 on Saturday, October 28, 2017. The fee is \$7.00 per student per event entered. Checks may be written to *Carnegie Vanguard High School* with *Mu Alpha Theta* listed on the notes section.

Events offered for 6-12 are TMSCA Number Sense, Calculator Applications, Mathematics, and Science. Mature elementary kids may compete in the 6th grade division. Computer Science written exam (from A plus CS) will be offered for high school students. TMSCA guidelines will generally be followed. You are encouraged to preregister as soon as possible; however, walk-ins on the day of the tournament will be accepted. *Coaches are expected to help in the grading room.*

Parking: regular vehicles can be parked in our two story garage or side streets. Buses may park on side streets, especially along Genesee St. or W. Gray St.

Middle school awards will include individual trophies for places 1-3, medals for places 4-6, and ribbons for 7-10 for each event for each grade level. 1st and 2nd place team trophies will be awarded for each event, and 3 sweepstakes trophies will be awarded. High School awards will include individual trophies for places 1-3, medals for places 4-6, and ribbons for 7-10 for each event for each grade level. 1st and 2nd place team trophies will be awarded for each event, and 2 sweepstakes awards will be awarded. Also top Bio, Chem, and Physics will be given plaques. *ALL TIES WILL BE BROKEN* for award purposes.
