

Primary Name That Book Team Information

Calling all K, 1, 2 students who love to read!

We are looking for readers with good conduct to try out for our Name That Book team. The 6 students (and 1 alternate) who make the highest test scores at the try-out will compete for our school at the Name That Book Competition in February/March.

Parents, we will have a more detailed information session in September/October on TEAMS. Flyers will be in a Monday Folder and posted on the Askew website.

For now, we want all interested students to start reading as many books as possible from the book list. When you read a book, you MUST:

1. Keep a journal of the titles you have read
2. Make notes about each book (characters/setting/problem/solution/plot/beginning...)
3. Write down direct quotes from the book that are significant or quotes you like and find interesting

Our try-out test will cover books 1 – 15 on the list, but students should also read books from the last half of the list, too. (If they make the team, then they will be more prepared.)

Currently, we do not have any of the titles at our Askew Library—they won't arrive for a few months. Other ways to get the books include:
