SIP goals proposal Closing the Gaps (SSO must approve) we will review every meeting:

- 1. ELAR by June 2023, mastery level STAAR 58% to68%
- 2. Math by June 2023 mastery level STAAR 50%-65% Carnegie program (5-year timeline) vetted by TEA, a tool for gaps
- 3. One-year academic growth increase by 10% based on STAAR Math and Reading Assessment (utilizing Renaissance, B.O.Y, M.O.Y., E.O.Y.)
