Guidelines and Expectations



Prom

Students, parents, and guests (if applicable) must sign this document and return it at the time of ticket purchase. Prom will be held Saturday, May 14, at 7:00 p.m. at the Conrad Ballroom of the Hilton at the University of Houston.

1. Students with an unexcused absence the Friday before prom will not be permitted to attend.
2. Students will purchase ticket(s) prior to April 29, 2022. Cost--\$25 for EECHS Seniors and \$75 for guests. Tickets can be purchased on the Class of '22 website at <https://www.houstonisd.org/site/default.aspx?PageID=193263>
3. Prom check-in begins at 7:00 p.m. and ends at 9:00 p.m. Students arriving later than 9:00 p.m. will only be admitted if parent/guardian escorts them to the venue.
4. Prom ends at 11:00 p.m. Students will not be permitted to leave prom until 10:45 p.m. Upon the conclusion of the event, all participants will be required to leave the venue. EECHS is not responsible for violation of Houston curfew hours. Parents/guardians of minors (students under 18) assume full responsibility of students after 11:00 p.m.
5. Students are required to stay inside the prom venue once they have entered. Students that leave the venue will not be granted re-entry.
6. HISD and EECHS rules and policies will be implemented and enforced at prom. All guests are required to abide by these rules as well. All prom attendees must be between the ages of 16-20.
7. Students wanting to bring a guest are required to complete and submit the "Prom Permission Guest Form" before the deadline.
8. Non-EECHS attendees will be required to show a government-issued ID prior to being admitted into the venue.
9. Students and guests are expected to show up to the event free of drugs, alcohol, and all other illegal substances. Any suspected violators of this policy will be detained by law enforcement officers.
10. All students, and guests must adhere to the EECHS dress code:
 - Formal attire must be worn the duration of the event
 - Gowns and other attire must cover the body. Spaghetti straps and strapless fashions can be worn, but attire is expected to be relatively modest. Attire that exposes midriff and/or lower back will be considered excessively revealing and not permitted. Sheer/see-through clothing is not permitted.
 - Shoes and shirts are required for the duration of the event. Flip-flops are not permitted.
 - Bags and backpacks are subject to search upon check-in. Students and their guests are expected to comply with requests to search bags/pockets from school officials or officers.
 - Students or guests violating the dress code will not be permitted to enter the prom venue.
 - For questions about appropriate attire, consult with Principal Square, Ms. Varela, or Ms. Calvert. EECHS administration reserves the right to deny entry or remove attendees failing to comply with dress code.
