45 minutes of students working on their own to complete class assignments.



End of Class

Note: With the asynchronous learning model, students may remotely work on their assignments outside of regular school hours just like they would when doing homework in a face-to-face learning environment.

# DRESS CODE

## 2020-21 Campus Dress Code

*The Waltrip student dress code means that students will dress appropriately for the learning environment at school and for school-related activities*

**ID Badges:** Students are required to wear their ID badge with a lanyard around the neck at all times while on campus. All students will be issued one ID badge and a lanyard.

**Shirts:** Although there is no color requirement for clothes, shirts must have arm sleeves and must cover top of the pants. Shirts must be worn in such a manner that no cleavage or midriff is exposed.



**Pants:** Pants must fit appropriately at the waist and crotch. That means no sagging pants. Skirts, shorts, skorts must be of appropriate length (not above mid-thigh). Jeans (or any pants) may not have any holes or tears in them. No jogging pants, sweat pants, athletic pants, basketball shorts, biking shorts or leggings, workout or athletic attire may be worn at any time unless directed to do so by a coach during athletic or P.E. class.



**Undergarments:** Students must wear appropriate undergarments at all times. Undergarments must NOT be visible, including underneath clothing.



**Headwear:** Hats, caps, bandanas, skull caps, do-rags, hoods or any other head covering may not be worn at any time while on campus, whether inside or out. Hoodless sweatshirts or fleeces are encouraged. Waltrip fleeces in school colors are available at the Waltrip Student Store.

# ATTENDANCE COUNTS!

- ✓ Students who engage in learning activities via the HUB, participate in A teams meeting with teachers, or submit assignments via the HUB are considered “present” and will not be marked absent.
- ✓ State law TEC §25.092 and Houston ISD policy still require students to attend at least 90% of their classes to receive credit and be promoted.
- ✓ Remote attendance will count in the same manner as on-campus (face-to-face) attendance in satisfying this requirement. Students who have not had contact with their teachers by 3:30 PM will be marked absent.



# ATTENDANCE CONTINUED...

**Students can engage with their teacher though the following:**

- ✓ Daily participation in the HUB, use of assigned digital tools, and/or group interactions.
- ✓ Interaction with teacher via teams as part of live or small group instruction.
- ✓ Students assignment submission via the hub for each scheduled class. When unable to submit via the HUB students can submit assignments via emails, photos, phone conferences or other forms of documentation.

# ATTENDANCE CONTINUED...

- ✓ Students are counted as present if they attend a live class, log into the HUB and submit an assignment, or check-in with their teachers otherwise.
- ✓ Students who have not had contact with their teachers by 3:30 pm will be marked absent.
- ✓ Phone calls made by 6:00 pm.
- ✓ Absences can be cleared if students logs in by 11:59 pm to complete an assignment for each course.
- ✓ The 90% rule is still in play.

# GRADING POLICY

- ✓ Students enrolled in remote instruction follow the same grading guidelines as in-person instruction. Teachers receive support and guidance on effective grading practices to ensure that grading guidelines are followed in both instructional models.
- ✓ Grades will be taken during each grading cycle of the 2020-2021 school year. All cycle grades will be used in the calculation of the final average for any class. Final exams will be administered for all high school credit courses.
- ✓ **Each grading cycle carries a weight of 25%:**

**Cycle 1 + cycle 2 + cycle 3 + final exam = semester average**

# SIX PARENT TIPS TO SUPPORT VIRTUAL LEARNING

- CREATING **DAILY SCHEDULE** AND REGULAR ROUTINE TO SUPPORT STUDENTS TAKING OWNERSHIP OF THEIR LEARNING AND STRUCTURING THEIR VIRTUAL SCHOOL DAY.
- PROVIDE A **DESIGNATED AREA** FOR LEARNING THAT **WILL LIMIT DISTRACTIONS** AND ALLOW YOUR STUDENT TO ***FOCUS ON SCHOOL LEARNING ACTIVITIES AND ASSIGNMENTS.***
- STAYING **IN COMMUNICATION** WITH THE CAMPUS AND **YOUR CHILD'S TEACHERS** TO PROVIDE SUPPORT THROUGHOUT YOUR CHILD'S VIRTUAL LEARNING EXPERIENCE.

# SIX PARENT TIPS TO SUPPORT VIRTUAL LEARNING

- **CHECKING IN WITH YOUR STUDENT** WILL SUPPORT THEM IN PROCESSING INSTRUCTIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS FROM THEIR TEACHERS. **CONNECT WITH YOUR STUDENT EVERY DAY AT A TIME THAT WORKS WELL FOR YOUR HOUSEHOLD.** THIS MIGHT BE A QUICK CHECK-IN A FEW TIMES A DAY OR A LONGER CHECK-IN IN THE MORNING OR EVENING.
- ENCOURAGE YOUR STUDENT TO **ENGAGE IN PHYSICAL ACTIVITY AND EXERCISE.** ALSO, ALLOW TIME FOR THEM TO GET UP AND MOVE AROUND DURING THEIR VIRTUAL SCHOOL DAY.
- KNOWING WHAT **TOOLS AND RESOURCES** YOUR **STUDENT HAS ACCESS** TO WILL ALLOW YOU TO BETTER SUPPORT YOUR STUDENT'S VIRTUAL LEARNING EXPERIENCE.
