## Final Exams:

2 hour exam...most of you are not accustomed to studying for an exam that covers the whole semester.
Preparation is different than studying for a unit test! \$1,000,000 question for your teacher: What is the best way to study for my final exam?

## Academics

Composite Grading

- Semester 1 Grade = 65
- Semester 2 Grade = 75
- Add both semester grades together, divide by two and average $=69.5$ or higher
- Or...the total points for both semesters must equal 139 or higher to earn credit for the entire course
