Texas Winter Storms: February 18, 2021

Millions Without Water, Power Amid Frigid Temperatures

Houston residents woke up Wednesday morning with little or no water pressure, on top of a third day of widespread power outages that have left millions without heat amid frigid temperatures, ice and snow.

Harris County Office of Emergency Management said the water issues were due to the ongoing power outages as well as burst pipes.

"Nearly (all) parts of the county are experiencing low water pressure – or have none at all, the agency tweeted. "Water utilities are struggling to operate in light of the state power issues. This will not improve until more power is restored."

In many areas, including the city of Houston, those with water are being advised to boil it before drinking. Those without power – 293,000 homes and business in Harrison County alone as of Wednesday evening – were being told to use bottled water.

Harris County Judge Lina Hidalgo, who oversees emergency management, called the combined water and power outages "a nightmare." Hidalgo said all residents should assume they are under a boil water notice.

Officials asked that water be conserved for essential use only.

"Conserving water will allow us to save water for firefighting operations and other life-safety items," the Office of Emergency Management tweeted.

Houston's William P. Hobby Airport was shut down for the rest of the day due to lack of water.

Temperatures were expected to be well below freezing again Wednesday night.

FEMA was sending generators, fuel and other supplies to the state. President Joe Biden declared a federal emergency.

The back-to-back storms, combined with the year-long coronavirus pandemic that hit Texas worse than many other states, are pushing residents to their limits.

Water outages also affected hundreds of thousands of residents Tuesday in other areas, including Abilene and Fort Worth. Water outages were also affecting residents in parts of Tennessee and Oklahoma.

In some cases, it was so cold overnight in Texas that water from burst pipes or running faucets froze inside homes. One residents said he used melted snow to flush toilets. The Austin Fire Department received more than 685 calls for broken water pipes between midnight and 7 p.m. Tuesday.

"Dispatchers are currently answering about 1 [Broken Water Pipe] call per minute," the agency tweeted. "We are only able to respond to a fraction of these calls."

More than 2.6 million homes and businesses remained without power in Texas on Wednesday, according to poweroutage.us. That was down from well over 4 million at the peak of the outages, which started Sunday night as power

plant equipment began to freeze and demand surged. Electricity providers were forced to initiate rolling blackouts in order to keep the entire grid from failing.

Now, no one knows how long the outages will last.

"The biggest variable that makes it difficult to give you a certain answer ... we're relying on ability to get that supply and demand in balance," Bill Magness, president and CEO of Electric Reliability Council of Texas, told reporters during a news conference Tuesday afternoon.

On Wednesday, Magness told reporters the best-case scenario would be power with rotating outages lasting 30 minutes to 60 minutes, starting later Wednesday or on Thursday morning, according to KUT-Radio.

Hypothermia and carbon monoxide poisoning cases continued to rise as the dire conditions drag on.

The back-to-back storms, named Uri and Viola by The Weather Channel, also hampered coronavirus vaccination efforts and created hazardous travel conditions in Texas and other states.

A portion of Interstate 20 eastbound in northwestern Louisiana was closed Wednesday morning.

"These are unprecedented times, and we need the communities' assistance and cooperation," Louisiana State Police said on Facebook. "Roadways remain impassable around our area, and we urge motorists to please avoid all unnecessary travel."

Ongoing power outages continued in several other states Wednesday morning, including more than 157,000 in Oregon, 100,000 in Kentucky, 71,000 in West Virginia and 49,000 in Louisiana.

And Duke Energy warned that up to a million homes and businesses in the Carolinas could lose power later this week as the winter weather treks to the east.

TEXAS — Churches, organizations, and businesses continue to welcome people in from the cold as Texas' winter storm creeps on for the third day in a row.

According to the National Weather Service, the accumulation of snow and ice came to an end for most areas on Wednesday with a tenth to a quarter-inch across Central and East Texas.
