I highly encourage you to buy the AMSCO book. It is available from the publisher (Perfection Learning) or Amazon.

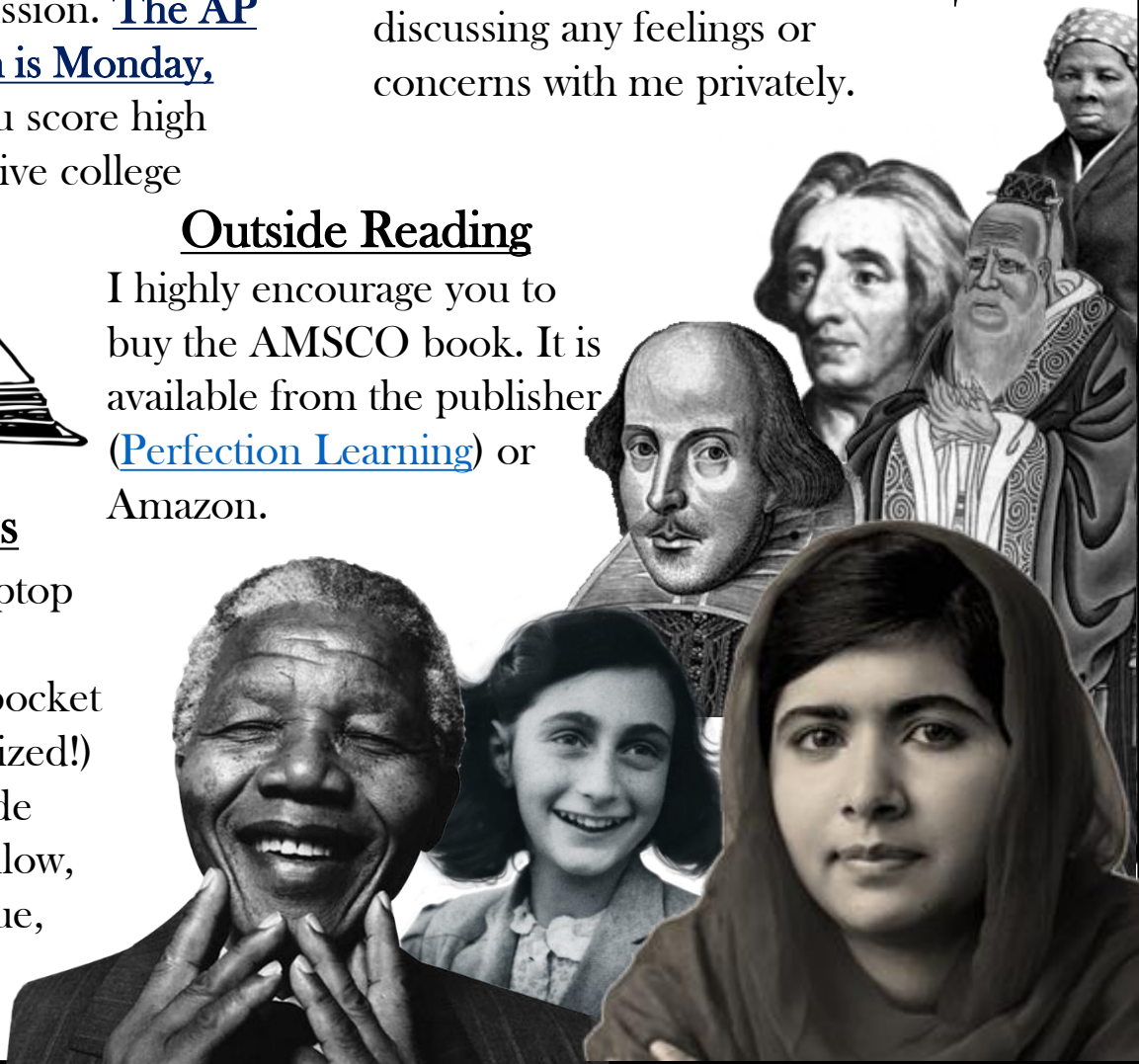

Major (70%): test, quizzes, projects, essays, etc. 10 points off every day; not accepted after 3 days late.

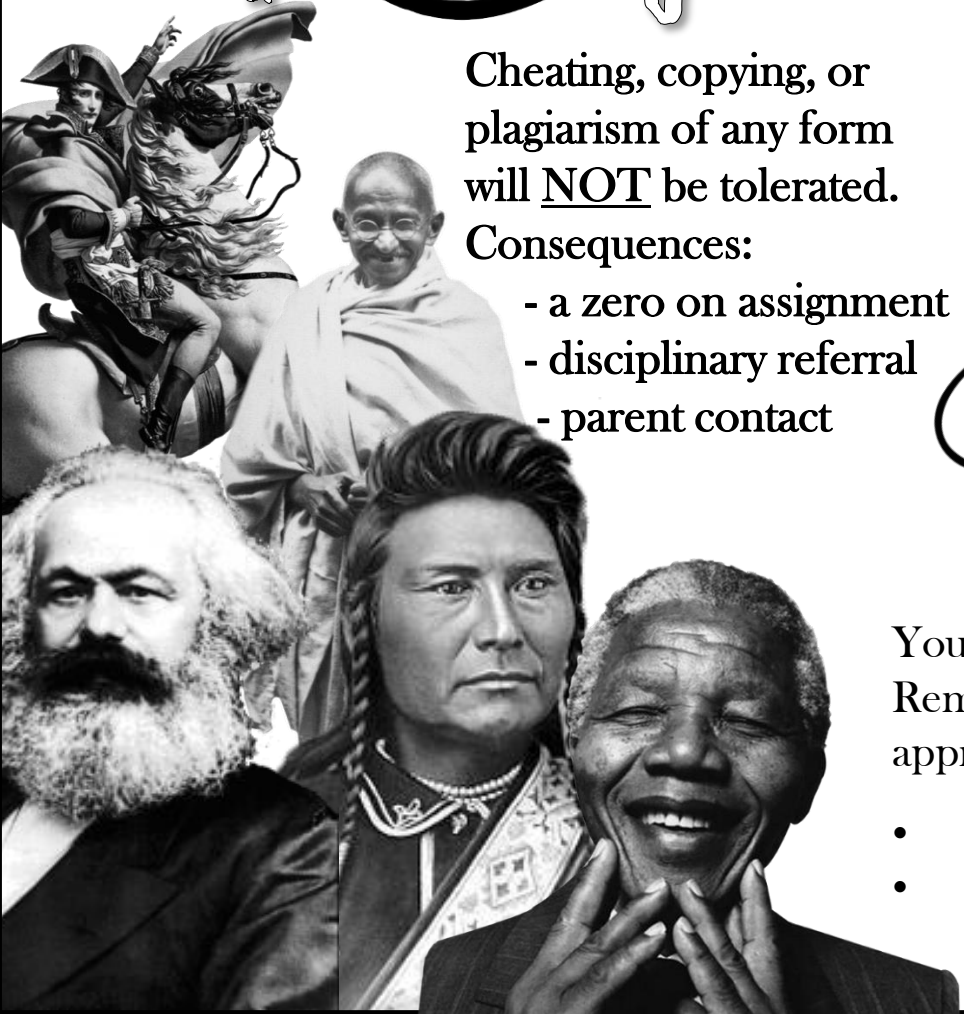
Minor (30%): daily assignments, homework, class discussions, readings, etc. No late work except when absent. It's your responsibility to get work.
