# Correctional Services Course Syllabus

## High School for Law and Justice/ Mrs. Donna Clark

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#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION:**

Students will learn the <u>role and responsibilities</u> of a county or municipal correctional officer. <u>Discuss relevant rules, regulations, and laws</u> of municipal, county, state, or federal facilities. <u>Discuss defensive tactics, restraint techniques, and first aid procedures</u> as used in the municipal, county, state, or federal correctional setting. Students will <u>analyze rehabilitation and alternatives to institutionalization</u> for inmates.
