Parents are getting involved in working with the school. ● Community came out to be part of the fall festival even families that do not have children at the school. ● Less discipline issues ● Student issues getting resolved quicker. ● Students being served by SEL team through the SAF form. ● More students being able to form more meaningful relationships with each other. ● Circle time is very impactful and provides an opportunity to check on students. ● IAT committee/Liaison Ms. Pettit is doing a great job of working to identify our students in need for services. ● Mrs. Ortiz has been very supportive of our students. Kinder team is doing well, talking and being supportive of everyone. <p>What needs to improve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● More Dojo communication, photos, and homework details. ● Homework should be going home every day. ● Communicating what is being worked on during the 9 weeks with parents. ● Parents need more communication from teachers. (3rd-5th) ● Grade levels need to be at 100%. ● After-school late pick-up ● During festival students were left alone without parents. Parents allowed their children to roam the festival without parent support. ● Better transition - (1st and 5th grade) - after lunch 11:30 a.m. ● Grade level restroom break - What grade levels use the restroom at what time. Revisit the schedule.
