**IE** is a web-based educational platform that accelerates grade-level reading and language proficiency in Spanish for students in K-5. Students in 3rd-5th may access IE for intervention in their native language. IE addresses the diverse instructional needs of native speakers, and targets foundational literacy skills in an engaging, game-like environment that celebrates the cultures of the Spanish-speaking world.
