

CVHS Reopening Plan

The option for face-to-face instruction on campus begins October 19, 2020. The following implementation plan at CVHS uses the district guidelines which may be found at <https://www.houstonisd.org/Reopening>. We understand that there may be unknown and unforeseen variables, but the following is our best attempt to address future needs. This plan is also subject to change based on guidelines provided by HISD as well as local and state officials. Please email cvhs@houstonisd.org if you have any questions.

CVHS administration reviewed the plan with students via a Teams meeting during advocacy on Monday, September 21st. Students have an opportunity to discuss options with parents in order to make an informed decision on selecting in-person or virtual instruction by Sept 24th. CVHS Reopening Plan

- Social distancing enforced in all areas of campus
- Club meetings will occur virtually.
- No use of lockers
- No visitors or guests allowed in the building
- Library use prohibited except for librarian's classes

CVHS Reopening Plan

Entry

- Students & employees receive temperature scan & wellness check.
- Students & employees are required to wear masks. Bring your own masks. HISD provides masks for those without them.

Between 7:30 and 8:30 AM, students may wait in the gym prior to access to classrooms.

CVHS Reopening Plan

Classrooms

- Approx. 9 - 14 student desks / chairs spaced 6 feet apart based on room size / set-up. Assigned seating for students.
- Between class periods, doors to the courtyard, outside fields, and classrooms will be opened to minimize contact.

CVHS Reopening Plan

Classrooms (continued)

- HISD maintenance is scheduled to disinfect classrooms. Students can assist.
- Hand sanitizers provided in all classrooms
- Plexiglass installed near teacher's desk as well as the student desk nearest the interactive white board.

CVHS Reopening Plan

Bathrooms

- The entry into bathrooms in the main building do not have doors. Privacy remains intact.
- Bathroom doors in the theater building and gym will be propped open.

CVHS Reopening Plan

Lunch

- Classroom delivery? TBD. No PTO sales.
- To minimize classroom contamination, we suggest students eat outside or in wide-open areas with social distancing measures.
- While not eating or drinking, students are asked to wear their masks at all times.

CVHS Reopening Plan

Proposal: Regardless of instructing in-person or virtually, teachers perform both simultaneously. Students who attend school in-person (and have teachers who instruct virtually) may be directed to the classroom set-up in the gym to attend that teacher's virtual lesson. This proposal helps avoid situations of students receiving instruction from unfamiliar teachers. This proposal is subject to change based on district guidelines.
