

## **COVID-19 Screening and Testing Information**

- COVID-19 testing is being conducted at Kelsey-Seybold Clinic after an individual clinical assessment is completed by a physician or Advanced Clinical Practitioner via a Video Visit. Each patient is individually assessed and a referral is made for COVID-19 testing if the patient meets the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) criteria. Patients are educated to continue to monitor symptoms and to keep in touch with their Kelsey-Seybold provider if symptoms change, if they have further questions, or if they are concerned for any reason.
- If the patient is referred for testing, they receive individual instructions from their doctor on the time and date of their COVID-19 test.
- Typical turnaround time for COVID-19 test results is 48 hours.
- Patients presenting with suspected COVID-19 symptoms are asked to first conduct a "Virtual Visit" for safety reasons. Patients receive personalized assistance from our Contact Center staff if they need help scheduling, setting up or conducting their visit.
- Patients with questions, needing assistance with Virtual Health Visits, or wishing to reach their physician's office can call our 24/7 Contact Center for help at 713-442-0000.
- Kelsey-Seybold is accepting new patients for Virtual Health currently.
- When patients need to speak with their doctor, they can call their doctor's office and can also message their doctor using MyKelseyOnline.com
- When patients need help after hours, our **24/7 Contact Center** is available at **713-442-0000** to connect patients to our After-Hours Nurse Triage Team. For life- or limb-threatening emergencies, patients should call **911**.
