

HISD has partnered with Books Between Kids, Harris County Precinct 2, PNC Grow Up Great, and the Dolly Parton's Imagination Library for an exciting new program called Book a Month. Children ages 0-5 within the 77012-zip code enrolled at Southmayd Elementary are eligible to receive one book a month. The books are free and will be delivered to the student's home, and nonenrolled children may be registered with a sibling who is enrolled at Southmayd. The cut-off age to register is 4 ½ yrs. of age, and once the child reaches the age of five, he or she araduates from the program and receives one last book. The books will be mailed to children 6 to 8 weeks after registration. This is a great opportunity to encourage literacy with our students and families and our overall communitu.
