Topics discussed:

- **Campus Needs Assessment**- no data back from STAAR. In terms of next school year, the target areas that want to get a higher level than “MEETS” are Alg.1; Biology; U.S. History. This year Math and Biology did well. The school also improved in the areas of Eng. 3&4 for the re-testers. Special Education will continue to be a target area for next year. Accommodations and compliance will still be a focus point in all classrooms.
- **Staffing**- Sam Houston will continue to have the same numbers of Assistant Principals for the 2024-2025 school year. We will have the same positions for next school year; however, we did lose one counselor position.
- **Instruction**- will stay the same, the campus will go back to three-week assessments. The school will also provide tutorials before and after school. There will be no teacher duties before and after school.
- **AI**- The campus has been approved for a weapon scanner for next year.
- **Budget**- is still secure and the campus will be able to afford everything that it needs for 2024-2025 school year.
- **Accountability Rating Score**- The school currently is rated as a “D” campus. Sam Houston is projected to be a “C” campus by the end of the year. Once all CCMR points have been accounted for the campus will be bumped up to a “B” campus.
