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What

What is the Read to Succeed competition?

The Read to Succeed competition is an opportunity for all PK-5 students to compete against each other to see who can read myON books for the greatest number of minutes. There is a district level recognition for the students who reads the most minutes per grade level.

What is the purpose of this competition?

The HISD Read to Succeed competition is designed to:

- Motivate and reward students for voluminous reading
- Increase time students are engaged in reading
- Increase reading stamina
- Increase access and use of the myON platform

What books can be read for the competition?

This competition is specifically for e-books available through the myON platform. A student may choose any book from myON to read.

What data will the reports pull?

Student winners: The reports will look at the total number of minutes read by PK–5 students for the time of the Initiative. **Campus winners:** The reports will look at the total number minutes read by campus per time-period and divide by the number of students at each campus. The School's Office Monthly recognition data will be collected on the last day of every month between October 31, 2021 and March 31, 2022.

What prizes/awards will be distributed to the winners at the geographic area level?

Trophies, social media templates or other type of awards will be provided to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place campus by School's Office. Trophies, certificates, or other type of awards will be distributed by Elementary Curriculum and Development/Library Services during the monthly Principal's Meeting. The award (traveling trophy or social media template) can be earned monthly. Work hard to keep your trophy/award or upgrade to a better one. Every month is a new chance, so keep at it! **At the district level**, prizes are being provided by Renaissance and will be awarded by the Elementary Curriculum and Development Department/Library Services and Renaissance during a June 2022 Awards Celebration.

Who

Who should participate?

All Elementary campuses are invited to participate. The competition is open to all PK-5 students.

Who will facilitate this reading competition?

Each participating campus should choose a designated "Read to Succeed Coordinator" to help promote the competition, encourage staff to participate, coordinate training opportunities for staff, run campus-based reports, and assist with coordinating area and district recognition awards if needed.

For school's office and district-level recognition, HISD's Elementary Curriculum and Development/Library Services will coordinate with the myON Project Manager for the promotion of the competition, reading reports to determine winners, awards, and recognition events.

Who will be recognized by the district?

The top 3 campuses (total # of minutes read ÷ total # of students) in each school's office (ES01, ES02, ES03, MSO & Achieve 180) will be recognized monthly at the monthly Principal's Meeting with a traveling trophy/certificate and/or social media posting.

At a culminating recognition event, the top winners across the district will be recognized. The data that determines these awards will be pulled midnight Wednesday, March 31, 2022.

The top winners include:

- Top three Elementary School per School's Office
- Top Elementary School Overall
- Top student (per grade, PK-5)

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When

When is the competition active?

The competition will run Friday, October 1, 2021 through Wednesday, March 31, 2022. Minutes read is NOT cumulative for the monthly school level competition, and resets after every recognition period. The district level recognition for students and campuses is based on cumulative minutes read.

When will reports be generated to highlight School's Office Winners?

Reports will be generated by the myON Project Manager, beginning November 2, 2021 – April 2, 2022 and sent to Library Services and School's Office the Tuesday prior to the Wednesday Principal Meeting date (exception January & February 2022)
