NCCER Announcement Regarding Retesting - Free Retesting Starts June 1st, 2021

To update and enhance the rigor and relevance of NCCER's module testing item banks, we have hired a psychometric testing firm to evaluate and write new questions.

In order to protect the integrity of these new questions, we are helping our network transition to the NCCER online Testing System.

Utilizing online testing reduces the chance of these new items being compromised.

This in turn ensures the credibility of the credentials.

To reduce the cost impact of this transition for our network, NCCER will no longer charge for retests starting June 1st, 2021. Just another reminder that online testing becomes mandatory on August 1st, 2021.
