The <u>Children's Environmental Literacy Foundation (CELF)</u> has a grantfunded <u>Civic Science</u> opportunity for 7 teachers to learn about capturing air quality and how to unpack air quality data.

This stipend program provides teachers with air quality devices, sessions on unpacking air quality data, and student presentation opportunities to local decision-makers.

The 6-hour G/T program includes two in-person connections - one in November (2 hours) & March (2 hours) - and another session in January (2 hours) virtually connecting with a data field expert. We also have virtual data exchange opportunities with students who are studying air quality in the states of California and New York along with students in the country of Ghana.
