Why 'flipped' learning from Adobe?

Flipped learning entails 'flipping' classroom activities traditionally confined to in-person education - discussion and collaboration, for instance - so that students can experience deeper and more meaningful learning outside of class. The flipped learning model can be a daily, weekly, or routine part of an in-person, online, or distance/remote learning classroom, and is a key strategy in helping to support meaningful education and student wellbeing in an online world.

In this course, we will introduce you to the essentials of flipped learning and explore a variety of key techniques that you can learn, master, and teach in (or out of) your own classroom. You will explore best strategies, approaches, and tools for creating effective flipped learning opportunities for your students, while also enriching your own creative skill set and deepening your knowledge.

Understanding Mental Wellness

Have you noticed the need to give students more coping strategies? EVERFI provides 6 free lessons that meet the National Health Education Standards (NHES)

- 1. Supporting students in identifying threats to mental health early and taking measures to increase factors that protect mental health.
- Introducing students to the experiences of others to develop awareness and empathy, reduce stigma, and provide facts on the prevalence and symptoms of mental health conditions.
- Fostering a mental health mindset to help students develop feelings of selfefficacy and skills that promote and model advocacy for self and others.
- 4. *New for 2022* Students learn the ways that changes outside of our control impact mental health including environment and unexpected events/sudden life changes (I.e., Covid-19 pandemic). A new lesson teaches mental health warning signs and provide resources for students and when they would be appropriate for referral.
