



## HOW LONG DOES A STUDENT OR STAFF MEMBER NEED TO QUARANTINE/ISOLATE



TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

DAY 1

- Begin self-isolation

DAY 6

- They have been isolated for **5 days** and can return to in-person school on **Day 6** if they have been fever free for a full 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication and symptoms are improving



HAS SYMPTOMS CONSISTENT WITH COVID-19

DAY 1

- Strongly encouraged to get a COVID-19 test immediately
- **If they test negative** they are eligible to return to school/work with evidence of the negative result when they have been fever-free for a full 24-hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and symptoms have improved

DAY 6

- **If they test positive** they are eligible to return to school after **5 days** of isolation if they have been fever-free for a full 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication and symptoms are improving



UNVACCINATED\* & HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT OF A CONFIRMED CASE

DAY 1

- Begin quarantine

DAY 5

- Strongly encouraged to get a COVID-19 test
- Continue to wear a mask around others

DAY 6

- **If they test negative** they are eligible to return to school on **Day 6** if they:
  - Are fever-free for 24-hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
  - Their symptoms are improving
- They must continue to isolate at home if their symptoms are not improving and they have a fever



VACCINATED\*\* & HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT OF A CONFIRMED CASE

DAY 1

- The close contact must provide proof of vaccination
- As long as they do not have symptoms, they do not have to quarantine

DAY 5

- Strongly encouraged to get a COVID-19 test
- No further action is required



HAD COVID-19 WITHIN PAST 3 MONTHS & HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A CLOSE CONTACT OF A CONFIRMED CASE

DAY 1

- The close contact must provide proof of infection within prior 3-months
- As long as they do not have symptoms, they do not have to quarantine

\*Unvaccinated refers to those who are unvaccinated and have been identified as the close contact of a confirmed case.

\*\*Vaccinated refers to those who are boosted or up to date on their vaccination and have been identified as the close contact of a confirmed case.
