Greetings and welcome back to the 2022-2023 school year! As we begin this school year, I wanted to provide resources and forms needed to maintain a healthy school year.

Your child's health and safety are my top priorities. Please read this information carefully to help ensure the safety of your student and the entire Wisdom community. I have provided attached links for each form.

Please let the school Nurse know:

• If your child's medical status has changed (new medication started, medication discontinued, new medical condition or condition resolved etc.)

• MEDICATION will only be given by the school Nurse under these conditions per HISD policy (no exceptions will be made)

o Parent/guardian brings a completed HISD medication order form signed by both the parent and the physician.

o Medication is delivered to the clinic by the parent guardian and is in the original container with the child's name printed on the label. (This includes over the counter medication, for example Benadryl for an allergy, just ask the pharmacist wherever you are purchasing the medication)
