Algebra I Grading Categories:

(40%) Daily Grades

Classwork - Work done in class may be graded at the teacher's discretion.

Quizzes - To assess student understanding after a small series of lessons.

Homework- Practice done at home or on free time at school.

(60%) Major Grades

Tests - To assess student understanding after a whole unit.

Algebra I Make-up Work/Redo Policy:

Work not completed due to absences:

If your child misses any work due to absences, it must be made up as soon as possible during after school tutorials under teacher supervision. Your child will have as many days as they were absent to get the work turned in. All work for a given unit must be made up by the date of the unit test.

Late work:

Five points will be deducted per day for a total of four days for late work. A maximum of 20 points will be deducted for late work.

Redo Policy:

Daily Grades and Assessments:

Any classwork, quiz, or assessment with a score below 70%, may be redone during after school tutorials under teacher supervision. The highest grade a student can earn on a redone assignment will be a 70%. A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade.

Major Grades:

A student has the opportunity to retake one test per six weeks. Tests may only be retaken if the student earned less than a 70. The highest grade given for a re-test is a 70. A student may not earn a grade lower than the original grade. These three steps must be followed in order for your child to retake a test.

- 1. Parent is made aware of the need to retake the test.
- 2. Stay for after school tutorials to correct the test with help from the teacher.
- 3. Stay for after school tutorials to make up the test under teacher supervision.
