Applying to a Vanguard Program

When applying for Vanguard programs parents must pick the first choice from the options below if the student is already prequalified as GT in both Reading and Math or if they are awaiting results of GT tests from GT testing in Nov/Dec 2023.



If parents pick Yes/Pending GT Test Results, all Vanguard schools will be visible for parents to select and apply. A student's GT Pre-Qualified status will also be visible as Yes or No, see example below.



If parents pick no as the response, the Vanguard schools will no longer be visible as an option to select and apply.

GT Results for students tested before
December 19, 2023, will be available in the
School Choice Application system before
Phase 1 closes. GT Results for students who
test later will be released after Phase 1 closes
and their application status will be Qualified
Pending. If they are offered a seat to a
Vanguard program in the lottery, it will be
conditional on them meeting the Vanguard
eligibility criteria.

For students entering kindergarten for the 2024-24 school year, or are currently 5th or 8th grade who missed Gifted and Talented testing within the Houston Independent School and are applying for Vanguard programs: Please initiate testing for your student by using this <u>link</u> and submitting your request by February 9, 2024. Please note that test results in this case may or may not be accessible before the closure of the School Choice application Phase 1 window. Please note that students must be gifted and talented in both Reading and Math to qualify for any Vanguard program in elementary, middle and high school.
