- Click the o icon on the course card to read the course description.

Core Requirement Rows

- Look for core requirement rows in red, this indicates the requirement is not yet met
- Select the pencil icon at the right of each row to edit the requirement



• Look for grade level credit requirements in red, this indicates the number of required credits for that grade is not yet met
