HCC Grading

- HCC grades are converted to numerical grades on the HISD transcript

HCC GRADE	HISD GRADE
A	95
B	85
C	77
D	72
F	60
FX	60
W	See Below

- Any college credit lower than a C is not transferrable to a 4-year university
- FX= student did not attend or did not complete work
- W= student withdrew from the class (does not affect GPA)

College GPA 2.0 GPA ="C" Average

When a student's Cumulative HCC GPA drops BELOW a 2.0, they are on probation for one semester (probation= can still take classes, must attend a SLIP session with HCC Counselor)

If a student on probation brings their SEMESTER GPA to 2.0 or higher, but their CUMULATIVE GPA is still below a 2.0, they are still on probation.

If a student on probation fails to bring their SEMESTER or CUMULATIVE GPA above a 2.0, they are now on suspension (suspension= cannot take classes, must attend multiple SLIP sessions)

If a student remains on probation for 2 semesters and fails to bring their CUMULATIVE GPA above a 2.0 during their 2nd probation semester, they are now on suspension.

After graduation, if a student chooses to transfer their "C" grades to a university, they should be aware that if their cumulative college GPA falls below a 2.0, they lose all of their financial aid and usually their scholarships.

Most scholarships require students to maintain between a 2.5-3.0 GPA to keep their scholarship.

How can I check on my student's HCC grades?



Unfortunately, HISD does not have any access to view HCC grades prior to the end of the semester.



Professors have the option to submit "Early Alerts" to notify students that they are in danger of failing, and we receive those alerts as well.



Students are responsible for maintaining their HCC grades.



Parents can ask students to go to HCC Canvas and click on "Grades" to view

HCC Canvas

1. Ask students to navigate to HCC Canvas
2. click on Courses
3. Select a course
4. click Grades
5. look for the "Total" in the top right corner
6. Repeat with each class
