2012 LANIER MATH TOURNAMENT

The 1st Annual 2012 LANIER MATH TOURNAMENT will be held on SATURDAY, May 19 at Lanier Middle School (2600 Woodhead St. Houston, TX 77098). Schools are invited to register 5-member teams of students in grades 5-8 to compete face-to-face. The opportunity for students to grow mathematically is unsurpassed, the problems are clever, engaging, and challenging, and the atmosphere is exciting for student and teacher alike.

Sponsored by the Lanier Middle School MathCOUNTS Club, the 2012 LANIER MATH TOURNAMENT will accept up to 20 teams of 5 students each. The registration deadline is May 5. Since space is limited and acceptance is on a first-come, first-registered basis, schools should enroll all their teams as quickly as possible. Teams can consist of students from different grade levels—within elementary and middle grades— and different schools. The registration fee is \$50 for a 5-person team or \$15 per individual. Students who sign up individually will be randomly grouped into 5-person teams for the team round.

Each team must be accompanied by a teacher or chaperone who will proctor a team from another school. Students and teachers should bring their own lunches and pencils. Mid-morning drinks and snacks will be served.

Calculators will not be permitted. Every student will receive a certificate of participation, and awards will be given to high scoring individuals and teams.
