LANIER DANCE AWARDS

Lanier Dancers have been busy the last few weeks!

In addition to hosting the HISD dance competition at Lanier on February 4, they also competed and blew away the competition!

Drill Team, Dance Team, Dance Company Officers, and Dance Company earned Super Sweepstakes awards, which means they earned a 90 or above from all judges on all their routines.

Dance Company was the third highest scoring team at the entire contest, placing ahead of all the other middle school teams and most of the high school teams.

The Drill Team won the High Point Award for their Novelty Routine.

The Dance Company won High Point Awards for their Jazz, Pom, Kick, and Prop routines.

In the large ensemble category, the 7th grade ensemble from Dance Team was the first runner up and Hip Hop Crew was the winner.
