#### LANIER'S INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE EVALUATION VISIT

As you know, Lanier is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School. On February 21st and 22nd, the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO) is sending three representatives to evaluate our program. Program evaluation is both a requirement and a service provided by the IB Organization to IB World Schools. The aim is for the IB to ensure that the standards and practices of the program are being maintained at Lanier. The purpose of the visit is not to appraise or assess individual teachers or school administrators. It is an aspect of the evaluation process that seeks to ascertain the effectiveness of the program implemented in the school. There are seven standards and practices that the IB evaluators will be assessing. They are: philosophy, leadership and structure, resources and support, collaborative curriculum planning, written curriculum, teaching and learning, and assessment.
