NJHS APPLICATIONS

If you are a **current 8th grader** and interested in applying for NJHS, the application deadline is **Monday, November 1.** 7th graders will not be able to apply until February.

To be eligible to apply:

- You must have an average of 93 or above on all report cards from 6th, 7th and the first nine weeks of 8th grade.
- You must have an average of E in conduct on all report cards from 6th, 7th and the first nine weeks of 8th grade.
- 3. Your application must include ALL report cards from 6th, 7th and the first nine weeks of 8th grade.

Incomplete and/or late applications will not be considered so be careful to include everything! Eligibility for application does not automatically ensure acceptance. Your community service, leadership abilities and outside interests/activities are all considered when looking at applications so fill out the application completely and tell us everything about you in every aspect of your life!
